Cords and Their Meaning

The Chesapeake Conference has adopted cords for identification of position. Please the meaning and the proper cord for each level.

1. We wear red because it symbolizes the Blood of Christ
2. The Conference Coordinators wear Gold to symbolize Holiness to be reached.
3. The Area Coordinators wear Silver to symbolize the Higher Standards we are all to have and encourage a leaders.
4. The Directors wear White to symbolize the Purity of actions, minds, and body we are to present before all.
5. The Black symbolizes the Trials of Leadership. Thus, the Club Staff wears the black because in all life we have trials but you have different ones to face as a leader and as a leader in Christ we know we don't face them alone.
6. Since the TLT's (Teen Leadership in Training) are leaders in training the Spotted white with the black symbolizes their training level on there way to be full pledged Club Staff.
